### **Seventh Grade Supply List**

#### **Binders**

Students will need to have separate, one inch, color-coded binders for each of their core subjects. The binders they will need are as follows:

Language Arts – Blue Social Studies – Green Math – Red Science – Orange Spanish – Yellow

### **General Supplies**

- Loose-leaf paper (enough to put some in each binder for notes and have spare paper to keep in locker)
- Three boxes of pencils to keep in lockers
- o Zippered pen / pencil holder to carry from class to class
- Small self-enclosed pencil sharpener to keep in pencil holder
- o Pens (blue and black)
- Highlighters (1 or 2 to store in pencil holder)
- One box markers (to keep in locker)
- One box colored pencils (to keep in locker)
- One two-pocked folder for communications from school to home
- One USB flash drive to save and store work

- One 2-pocket blue folder with punched holes
- o One 2-pocket green folder with punched holes
- Six dividers with tabs
- One marble composition book
- One pack of 3x5 note cards (to be kept in locker)
- o One pack of 3x3 post-its

#### **Mathematics**

- Ten red vinyl 2-pocket folders with fasteners (for three hole punched sheets)
- Colored pencils
- o Regular pencils with erasers (no pens, even erasable pens are not permitted)
- Scientific calculator to keep at home (TI 30x IIS, 2 line display recommended)
- o Graph paper, already 3-hole punched (4-5 boxes per square inch preferred)

#### Science

Four dividers

 Consider getting a slightly larger (1½ inch) binder for science, given the number of packets

# Spanish

- Three dividers
- Two packs of 3x5 index cards and an index card box (use your box from last year if possible)
- o One pocket Spanish-English dictionary
- Pencils and erasers
- Lined paper already in binder

#### **Unified Arts**

- One PURPLE two-pocket folder with clasps
- o Lined paper in your folder to take notes
- One sharp pencil
