Students have the chance to work in small groups, creating in-depth projects, while learning new skills. Enrichment clubs meet once a week. Each session includes 10 classes. Classes are taught in classrooms on our campus. Variations in beginning and completion weeks are due to clubs not being held on half-days or when GSFS is closed.

Lower School Art Enrichment Club; \$150 + \$30 supply fee

Lower School Art Enrichment will be led by GSFS parent and Germantown-based fine artist and teacher Lisa Haskell. Students will explore various materials through creating layered mixed media 2-D and 3-D pieces. Students will work with materials including cardboard, wood, yarn, paint, and ink. Each project will cover several steps ending with a thoughtful finished product. [Enrollment Min: 7/Max: 10 students]

Songwriting Group Ensembles; \$150 + \$5 supply fee

This unique class is designed to learn the basic concepts of improvisation, songwriting and team work, in a safe and respectful environment, where children can foster their self-expression. Children will work on developing lyrics and music ideas, adding different types of emotions and turning them into an original song. [Enrollment Min: 7/Max: 10]

Grades: 3rd & 4th

Class Time: Mondays from 3:15 - 4:15; March 2 - May 18, 2015

Creative Rhythms Percussion Ensemble; \$150 + \$10 supply fee

This class is designed to develop kid friendly themes into an original rhythm using percussion instruments, voice, and body percussion. Participants will develop basic musical skills, listening skills, basic stick and percussion technique, and all the imagination and creativity a child can express while playing in a group setting.
